## Archdiocesan Day of Prayer and Fasting for Peace in the Holy Land Friday, December 1st Appointed by Archbishop Naumann

All of the faithful are encouraged to ask Almighty God to grant peace and stability in the midst of the present war between Hamas and Israel. In addition to prayer, we are asked to fast and make personal sacrifices for the cause of peace, and to invoke the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, under her title Queen of Palestine, and all the saints, for the needs of all those suffering from the conflict and continued violence.

Among those forms of prayer in which the faithful might participate include: time in the Adoration Chapel, the Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, litanies of the Most Sacred Heart, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the Saints. We will continue to include a petition for peace in the Holy Land in the prayer of the faithful at the Sunday Mass. May all of the children of Abraham come to embrace one another as true brothers and sisters and to live in peace and harmony with one another in that land promised to him and his descendants.
