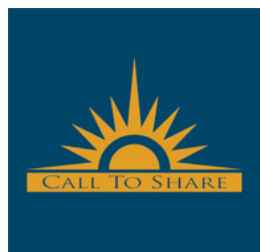

"Repent and believe in the Gospel" is one of a few possible phrases the priest says as he places ash on the foreheads of the faithful on Ash Wednesday.
